
Hollywood Comes to Pauls Valley!

From August 2-9 University of Southern California (USC) graduate film student, Rebecca Eskreis, will direct her short film, *Noodling*, in and around Pauls Valley. While the film's main location is Pauls Valley, *Noodling* is crewed predominately by the Norman and OKC Metro areas with approximately ten OU Film and Video Studies interns.

As a student film and a 501c3 Non Profit Organization, this project is operating on an extremely limited budget and they are requesting donations of materials and the use of items from local businesses and individuals that will be used in the production of this film. Some of the items needed include: Meals, Sun block, Water, paper goods & trash bags, gift cards, snacks, coolers, gas cards, bug spray,

toilet paper, etc... All donations are tax-deductible.

On average there will be 30 cast and crew members on set everyday, for a total of eight days, and they would greatly appre-


