# Pauls Valley Community Foundation Seeks Donations

Dear friends of the PVCF,

As of June 30, the PVCF administration fund was \$3965.70 and the endowment fund was \$48,268.80. This brings our total to \$52,234.50.

We have received \$5108.00 year to date in gifts. We need a little under \$5000.00 to meet our goal and receive the \$3000.00 match for 2010.

We have invested \$1500 in the downtown beautification project and \$1000 to the Pauls Valley welcome signs from a grant

awarded to us by the Oklahoma Initiative Fund. We still have \$500 left from this grant to improve the shelter in the parking lot south of the Daily Democrat. If anyone can come up with a way to improve this shelter for that cost, please contact me. The best bid came in at \$1700.00.

One success that we have had in fund raising has come from people who send memorials to the fund. Usually these gifts are in addition to flowers or in lieu of flowers. Some have even sent funds honoring living friends. Please let me know of other ideas that you may have to increase the

endowment. Remember that funds given to the foundation are not only tax deductible but are also permanent. Only the interest can be used to improve the quality of life in Pauls Valley and the surrounding area.

## Pauls Valley Rotary to host Second Annual Greater Garvin County Car Cruise "THUNDER IN THE STREETS"



The Rotary Club of Pauls Valley has announced that it will host the Second Annual Greater Garvin County Car Cruise "THUNDER IN THE STREETS" in Garvin County, scheduled for October 9, 2010.

Last year's Inaugural Greater Garvin County Car Cruise format will be transformed from a car cruise into a Car Show and Poker Run to benefit Rotary Service Projects.

Participants will not only be displaying their vehicles in designated areas around town, but will be driving their cars in around to specific pre-establish venues where they will collect proof of visit tokens and will then return to their staging area to draw cards for a Seven Card Stud Poker Hand.

The Car Show portion of the event and judging will begin at 1:00 pm and end at 3:00 pm. Trophies will be awarded for the best vehicles in a number of different classes at an awards presentation and event gathering after the Poker Run in the parking lot at Covercraft Industries at 5:00 PM.

The event is being designed as a Rotary Benefit fundraiser, which will not only provide for the many programs supported by the Rotary Club, but is open to any non-profit organization in the region. Sponsors have donated a 2003 Ford Mustang GT Convertible, which was unveiled at Brickfest, in Pauls Valley on May 1, 2010 to be raffled off on the day of the cruise. Any non-profit organization may participate in the raffle by purchasing bundles of tickets in increments of 100 for \$.50 cents each or \$50, selling them for \$2 each or \$200, and keeping the difference of \$150 to benefit the mission of their organization.

The 2010 event has been expanded to six classes to include Motorcycles and will henceforth be held on the second Saturday in October.
