Thank you for speaking with me today. As I mentioned, our company has created a subsidiary that engineers permanent outdoor audio systems for main streets. The systems can be used for daily ambient music of any variety, automated or live announcements, special event music, emergency notification, and automated clock chimes. The first system was installed in Perkins along with their Centennial Clock.

So far permanent systems have been installed in:
